Directions

From the West (Rt. 128): Take exit 26-Rt. 20 Waltham. Rt. 20 and Main St. are the same road. Drive for approximately 1.5 miles. The library is on the left past the MacDonald's and the Post Office at 735 Main Street.

From the East: Take Rt. 20/Main Street. The library will be on the right past City Hall and the intersection with Moody Street at 735 Main Street.

Parking: There is a metered parking lot behind the library. A metered municipal lot is also located one block from the library off of Lexington St. between Main St. and School St.
